BILL

To amend the Extradition Act, 1996 so as to delete the ground of refusal where a person is convicted in absentia by the requesting country

1. <u>Section 5: Restriction on return</u>

Amend section 5 (2) (a) of the act, by deletion of paragraph (a)

2. Short title and commencement

This act shall be called the Extradition Amendment Act, 2023, and shall come into operation on a date fixed by the president by proclamation in the Gazette
