In July 2025, a total of 27 Intelligence Request Documents (IRDs) were received, bringing the cumulative number of requests to 1,405.

During the current reporting period, the FIC recorded an increase in the volume of Suspicious Transaction Reports (STRs), Cash Transaction Reports (CTRs), Electronic Funds Transfers (EFTs), and Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs) compared to June 2025.




## 2. Classification of Reports

Of the 221 STRs filed in total, 98% (216 reports) were classified as low priority, while 5 reports were accorded high-priority status. Bank-B filed the majority of STRs during the month, submitting 107 STRs.


**Graph 2.3: Classification of SARs received by the Reporting Entities** 



Reporting entities filed 18 SARs, of which 1 was prioritized and escalated to a case.


## 3. Disclosures
