In July 2025, a total of 27 Intelligence Request Documents (IRDs) were received, bringing the cumulative number of requests to 1,405.




2. Classification of Reports

Bank-B filed the majority of STRs during the month, submitting 104 STRs. Of the 180 STRs filed in total, 94% (170 reports) were classified as low priority, while 9 reports were accorded high-priority status.


Graph 2.3: Classification of SARs received by the Reporting Entities



Reporting entities filed 23 SARs, of which only 1 report was prioritized and escalated to a case.


3. Disclosures
